 *HST = Half-square triangle - Cut a square on the diagonal. Each square makes 2 triangles. Triangle count required is given.

- Follow pattern instructions to make 56 blocks for the king quilt.
- Follow pattern instructions to lay out the quilt lay out 7 rows of eight blocks each.
- For the pieced border you will need 144 half-square triangle units.
- For each side border you will need 34 half-square triangle units
- For each top and bottom borders you will need 38 half-square triangle units. Extras are for adjustments.

Fabric Requirements (assumes 40" usable width)

Fabric	King 100¾" x 92¾" 56 blocks
Background	5 yards
Assorted leaf color fabrics	⅞ yard of 4 different fabrics or 3½ yards scraps
Dark brown	¾ yard
Accent border(s)	1 yard
Outer border	2⅞ yards
Binding	¾ yard
Backing	8⅞ yards
Batting	109" x 101"

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
