Fabric Requirements (assumes 42" usable width)

	Table runner 18″ x 42″	Andover fabric* numbers as in quilt shown
Green tone-on-tone print	¼ yard	A-7806-MG (green dot)
Green multi-color print	³∕% yard	A-7804-MG (green candle print)
Red print	³∕% yard	A-7806-MR (red dot)
Light background print	⁵⁄% yard	A-7805-G (green on white)
Gold print	scrap	
Fusible web (12" wide)	¼ yard	n/a
Binding	¹⁄₃ yard	A-7806-MR (red dot)
Backing	22″ x 47″	A-7803-MR (red Abbey and snow) print
Batting	22″ x 47″	

Tools: $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24" rotary ruler is recommended.

Cutting for the table runner

Note: Label pieces with letter in parenthesis where given.

Green tone-on-tone :

- 1 strip $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF for tall triangles
- 2 strips $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " (M) for scallop 'tree skirts'

Green multi-color print:

- 18 squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " for checkerboard border
- 1 strip $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF for tall triangles

Red print:

- 18 squares $3\frac{1}{2}'' \ge 3\frac{1}{2}''$ for checkerboard border
- 1 strip $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF for tall triangles

Light print:

- 2 rectangles 7¹/₂" x 17¹/₂"; with rectangles wrong sides together, cut on one diagonal to make 2 HRT (I) and 2 reverse HRT (Ir)
- 2 strips 5" x 14" (J) for tall tree blocks
- 2 strips 2" x 13¹/₂" (L) for 'tree skirt' background

Gold print:

• Stars - SSee "Preparing the tree skirt & stars" in the Abbey Christmas pattern.

Fusible web:

- 2 strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " for 'tree skirt'
- Stars See "Preparing the tree skirt & stars" in the Abbey Christmas pattern.

Binding

• 4 strips $2^{1}/4''$ x WOF

WOF = width of fabric from selvage to selvage HRT = half-rectangle triangle

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Following 'Preparing the tree skirts & stars' in the Abbey Christmas pattern, make 2 tree skirts and 2 large stars.

Following 'Cutting & trimming the tall 45° triangles' in the Abbey Christmas pattern, cut the 2 ³/₄" strips into triangles for 2 tall trees, same as for the wall quilt.

Following 'Making the tall tree blocks' in the Abbey Christmas pattern, make 2 tall tree blocks.

Layout the blocks and squares as shown in the diagram.


Sew the tree blocks together. Press seam allowances open.

Join the 4 squares for the top and bottom of the trees. Press seam allowances all in one direction. Sew to the trees paying careful attention to the order of the squares.Press seam allowances toward the squares.

Join the side squares and press seam allowances all in one direction.

Fuse gold stars to the tops of the trees. Secure the fused stars with a satin, zigzag, or decorative stitch.

Follow 'Quilting & finishing' in the Abbey Christmas pattern to complete the quilt.



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
