Pattern for paper pieced tablerunner and quilts in 5 sizes. Fabric requirements for throw, twin and full double quilts are on page 11. Basic paper piecing instructions are included.

For bright spring or summer flowers, choose 2 tones of blue, yellow, or pink. For a christmas project choose 2 tones of red, or try white and off white on a dark background. To make the flowers really pop, choose a bright yellow for the flower center. High contrast in value or color between the flowers, leaves and background emphasizes the-pleasing shapes of the flowers.
